## Articles of Organization Adapted 1/9/2025

Whereas, Discovery Park is the venue for periodic, loud concerts and

Whereas, the music is amplified out of speakers three stories tall and

Whereas, the speakers generate noise pollution to a square-mile section of South Natomas and

Whereas, a Sacramento County general ordnance says, "Every person in the County is entitled to live in an environment free from excessive, unnecessary or offensive noise levels[.]" and

Whereas, a Sacramento County general ordnance says, "The Sacramento County Board of Supervisors finds ... excessive ... noise within the County is detrimental to the public health[.]" and

Whereas, a Sacramento County general ordnance says, "[Outdoor concerts] will not unreasonably interfere with ... the promotion of public health[.]" and

Whereas, a Sacramento County general ordnance says, "[Outdoor concerts] will not unreasonably interfere with ... the general public enjoyment of the park."

Therefore, I, the undersigned, being a citizen of the United States, form the following as a non-profit organization under the California Government Code, section 12585 and IRS 501(c)(4).

Name: Keep Discovery Park Quiet

Location: Sacramento County

The purpose of Keep Discovery Park Quiet is to protect the physical environment of Discovery Park and the ambient environment for residents of South Natomas. The protection method is to persuade or judicially force the Sacramento County Regional Parks Director to no longer issue the permit for loud concerts at Discovery Park.

The founding trustee of Keep Discovery Park Quiet is: Timothy Howard Riley, 1966 Delgado Way, Sacramento, CA, 95833

Keep Discovery Park Quiet is organized for not-for-profit purposes. As such, all officers will obey the following restrictions:

- 1) No part of the revenues of the organization shall be distributable to, inure the benefit of, neither directly nor indirectly, its trustees, officers, members, or other persons.
- 2) Upon the dissolution of the organization, any fixed assets shall be sold. All cash accounts shall be merged into one cash account. The one cash account shall be donated to the Sacramento County Department of Regional Parks.
